

# *Need a urine sample?* **Urine luck**

Here are two ways you might not have thought of to make at-home urine sample collection a little easier.



**O**ccasionally, your veterinarian might ask you to collect a urine sample from your pet at home. Seem like an impossible task? Here are two simple ways to get that urine sample with items you probably have around the house.

## **You'll never look at a banana split the same way again...**

Believe it or not, banana split bowls work better than a typical bowl does because their oblong shape and shallow depth fit better between the legs and under short dogs, and their extra length keeps your hands away from the urine stream.

## **Popcorn anyone?**

Don't actually pop it, just replace your cat's litter with unpopped popcorn kernels. The corn is similar to kitty litter in texture but doesn't absorb urine. After your cat uses the litter box, you can easily pour the urine into a container and bring it into the veterinary clinic for analysis.
